FEBRUARY 14-17, 2021: THE 67th RALLYE NEIGE ET GLACE

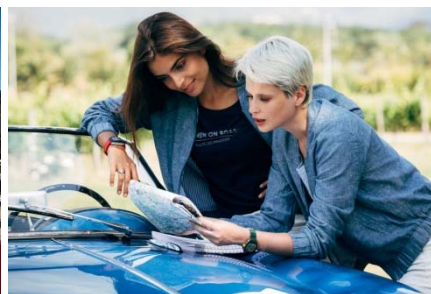
